

# COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

## Preamble

Estonian Association of Nurse Anaesthetists and Intensive Care Nurses (EAAIN), J. Sütiste str 19, 13419 Tallinn, Estonia will be represented by chairman Helen Valk.

Latvian Nurses Association, Anaesthesia, Intensive and Emergency Care Union (AINA), Skolas str. 3. Riga LV-1010 Latvia, will be represented by the council member Evija Baksa-Zveja.

Lithuanian Society of Anaesthesia and Intensive Care Nurses (LAITSD), Santariškių g.2, Lithuania, will be represented by chairman Daiva Didvalė.

Have agreed to work together to develop cooperation with Baltic States associations of nurse anesthetists and intensive care nurses. This agreement describes their understandings and commitments to this collaborative effort.

## Corporate communication

The EAAIN and AINA and LAITSD will work closely together to ensure that our communications activities are mutually beneficial. We will share information – including about significant upcoming events, trainings, publications, media relations and other communications work. We will seek out opportunities to work collaboratively wherever possible.

## Term of this agreement

This agreement takes effect from 24 October 2019. The agreement will last in force until revoked in writing by any party or superseded by a future agreement. It is expected the agreement will be reviewed by October 2020 in order to reflect year`s progress.

## Updates to this agreement

Any party may propose amendments to this agreement at any time and these will be subject to agreement. Amendments will come into effect on a date to be agreed by all parties.

## Disputes

In the event of any dispute arising from or in connection with this agreement, the parties will in good faith seek to resolve that dispute using a method acceptable to all relevant parties.
